

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTS / STUDENTS

Subject to favourable pandemic conditions and conducive government instructions, the CAMPUS proposes to restart the regular teaching programme wef 2nd/ 3rd week of September 2020. However, keeping in view the pandemic related risks, the teaching mode of classroom teaching has been modified to classroom cum online mode of teaching. within the pandemic dictated health norms till further orders.

1. The institutions will function all the 7 days of the week 9AM-5PM.
2. No holidays as prescribed in the official calendar will be permitted during 2020 except the day of Diwali
3. Entry in the campus on each day will be subject to screening for the following
 - i. Combination of symptoms: fever-dry cough-tiredness
 - ii. Satisfactory Arogya Setu display on the mobile of the student
 - iii. Face Mask adequately covering face
 - iv. Thermal Screening with body temperature not being over 99° F
 - v. Finger Tip O₂ saturation not less than 90 %

This drill will be conducted every morning. Any student failing on any parameter as listed above will not be permitted to enter in the campus

4. The Campus is now under CCTV surveillance and anyone found to default on any one of the following counts will be fined Rs 1000/- on the first default. The 2nd. 3rd and successive defaults will attract a fine of Rs. 5000 and 10,000 respectively.
 - i. FACE not covered properly by the mask
 - ii. Social distance of 2M not maintained
 - iii. Open Spitting, Pan Gutka Consumption or Smoking in the campus

ADVISORY FOR THE STUDENT

5. Special attention shall be paid by the student:

In maintaining perfect personal hygiene including clean washed clothes

Periodic handwash with soap and water during stay in the campus.

Maintaining health etiquette while coughing/sneezing

Student is advised to bring his/her tiffin box. No prepared food will be available in the campus canteen.

No litter will be thrown outside Litter boxes

Students will be allocated their places in classrooms/ laboratories and in buses which will be maintained by him/her all along

The student is expected to ensure to complete the following requirements:

2. Clear all the pending College and Hostel dues (where ever applicable) including College fees for the session 2020-21 if not paid earlier
