Fees: Fees are required to be paid in accordance with the schedule given on the college website, within the specified period with a grace period of 7 days at the discretion of the Principal of the College. Late fee will be charged @ Rs 100 per day for 10 days beyond the grace period. Any further delay in payment of fee will carry a penalty of Rs 5000/- and or suspension from the College. Even though, in case of some unprecedented circumstances University/ Council examination may be delayed, the College fees is required to be paid on due dates as the courses are running courses with the provision of promotion to next phase of the course. Absence from the College for medical or other extraordinary situations authorized by the competent authority of the College for period of one semester or more shall be permitted only on payment of the fee for the period of absence in advance. Payment of Bus fees is optional and is to be paid for those availing of college transport For the current session the fee has been fixed @ Rs 8000/ for north of Tawi areas and Rs 9000/- for Trans-Tawi areas. Students granted admission are required to report within the period notified by the College. In case of those who fail to report or wish to withdraw within 10 days of notified date of admission the fee already paid shall be refunded in full less admission fee; those wishing to withdraw after 10 days but within 20 days of the notified date shall be eligible to a refund of 50% of the fee payable for the first year. No refund of fee shall be made for a period of withdrawal thereafter. Such a request must, however be made in written mode to the office of Director directly in person or via online or by registered post in which case the date of receipt date shall be deemed to be the effective date.

Hostel Facilities: The institution has leased suitable accommodation for residence of outstation students for boys and girls which are administered by hostel wardens. These residences are covered by 24x7 security and the inmates are required to follow hostel rules including absence from the hostel after the prescribed closing hours. The hostel fees per year are Rs. 45000-50000 payable at the beginning of the session or may be paid on monthly basis @ 4500- 5000 pm. However, in the latter case the inmate has to keep a security of one month of hostel charges which is refundable on the exit of the inmate permanently from the hostel. In case of premature termination of residence of the inmate due to any reason, the excess amount paid if any, will be refunded subject to the condition that during of stay in the hostel for more than one week will be reckoned as full month
