In partial modification of previous instructions for reopening of the Campus for physical classes, the physical classes will begin now from 26th of July instead of the earlier scheduled date the 15 July. The change has been necessitated by the Government notification of vacation period upto July 25th. There will also be a break for online classes from 5th – 10th of July in view of the prevailing severe heat wave weather conditions. Online teaching will restart uninterrupted from 12th July onwards till resumption of physical classes for all the disciplines, including those students who have just completed their JKPMC examinations. The last date for completion of University registration for B.Pharmacy Ist semester for students belonging to places outside Jammu Town is also deferred to July 25th

Students of final year D.Pharm who have completed their 2nd year examination are hereby informed that their practical training will start shortly for completion of their Part III of the Diploma Pharmacy course. These students must keep in touch for further instructions in this matter and these instructions will be notified on the www.phcopjk.in in a few days. It is stressed that as per pharmacy Act 1948 which has now applicable to J&K, the diploma in pharmacy course requires passing of Part I , Part II followed by completion of 3 months of practical training component in form of Part III component, as per PCI protocol which is essential for award of the qualification and for registration as a pharmacist in the country.
